Required for the solicitation and selling of auto insurance, homeowners, commercial policies, workers compensation, liability insurance, etc.

Personal Lines License

This license allows the transaction of personal lines insurance; such as personal auto insurance and homeowners.

Licensing Process

If you are working with a life insurance company and want to solicit variable products, a Series 6 or Series 7 AND 63 registration with FINRA is required. Check with the insurer regarding broker/dealer to find out their specific requirements and process to file the Form U-4 Application. (For more information visit www.finra.org)

There are no Prelicensing requirements. This leaves the individual to prepare for the securities licensing exam on their own. There are many options to preparing for the securities exam. Self study or live classroom exam prep (cram course). We have options for you and recommend classroom training. Live classroom interaction allows the trainer to assess what areas to focus on in the classroom based on student interaction and emphasize subject matter likely to be seen on the exam.

Important to remember

Filing the Form U-4 opens a 120 day window. Open the window by filing the U-4 Application when ready to take the licensing exam. Once the window is open, then contact PROCTOR to schedule the licensing exam.

Second attempt requires a 30 day waiting period after the first exam date. Third attempt requires a 60 day waiting period, then the fourth attempt a six month waiting period prior to scheduling your next exam date.

Products Representative Examination (IR): The Series 6
exam—assesses the competency of an entry-level representative
to perform his or her job as an investment company and variable
contracts products representative. The exam measures the
degree to which each candidate possesses the knowledge needed
to perform the critical functions of an investment company and
variable contract products representative, including sales of
mutual funds and variable annuities.

Number of Questions: 100 scored questions & five unscored

pretest questions.

Time: Two hours and 15 minutes Passing Score: 70 % or better

Series 6 Permitted Activities: A candidate who passes the Series 6 exam is qualified for the solicitation, purchase and/or sale of the following securities products: Mutual funds (closedend funds on the initial offering only), Variable annuities, Variable life insurance, Unit investment trusts (UITs), Municipal fund securities (e.g., 529 College Savings Plans, local government investment pools (LGIPs), and Coverdell Education Savings Accounts).

**Series 63 - Uniform Securities State Law Examination

The Series 63 exam — the Uniform Securities State Law Examination — is a North American Securities Administrators Association (NASAA) exam administered by FINRA.

Number of Questions: 60 scored questions. Time: 75 minutes to complete the exam Passing Score: Correctly answer at least 43 of the 60 scored questions. 72%

*Series 7 - General Securities Representative Examination (GS): The Series 7 exam—assesses the

competency of an entry-level registered representative to perform his or her job as a general securities representative. The exam measures the degree to which each candidate possesses the knowledge needed to perform the critical functions of a general securities representative, including sales of corporate securities, municipal securities, investment company securities, variable annuities, direct participation programs, options and government securities.

Number of Questions: 250 scored questions and an additional 10 unscored pretest questions.

Time: Six hours-Two three-hour sessions (130 ques per session) Passing Score: 72 % or better
